



Intimate Partner Violence Coding Summary

IPV Assessment Codes

There are no ICD-10 or CPT code for IPV screening, but there are LOINC assessment codes:

- LOINC 911221000124107 Pre-Screen: CUES Implementation
- LOINC 76499-3 HARK: Humiliation, Afraid, Rape, and Kick Questionnaire
- LOINC 93025-5: PRAPARE (which includes an optional set of IPV questions)

Diagnosis

There are ICD-10 codes for adult abuse when the abuse has been diagnosed. The codes are as follows:

- T76.11XA-Adult physical abuse, suspected, initial encounter
- T74.11XA-Adult physical abuse, confirmed, initial encounter
- T76.31XA-Adult psychological abuse, suspected, initial encounter
- T74.31XA-Adult psychological abuse, confirmed, initial encounter
- T76.21XA-Adult sexual abuse, suspected, initial encounter
- T74.21XA-Adult sexual abuse, confirmed, initial encounter

External cause codes may be reported in addition to the abuse diagnosis codes to provide details on the identity of the specific perpetrator. The Y and Z codes are as follows:

- Z91.414 Adult intimate Partner Violence
- Z63.0 Problems in relationship with spouse or partner
- Z91.410 Personal history of adult physical and sexual abuse
- Z69.11 Encounter for mental health services for victim of spousal or partner abuse
- Z69.12 Encounter for mental health services for perpetrator of spousal or partner abuse
- Y07.03 Male partner, perpetrator of maltreatment and neglect
- Y07.04 Female partner, perpetrator of maltreatment and neglect
- Y07.05 Non-binary, perpetrator of maltreatment and neglect
- Gender non-conforming, perpetrator of maltreatment and neglect

Procedure Codes:

There are currently no CPT codes specifically for IPV: However, the following Preventive Medicine Service codes 99381-99397 can be used and include age appropriate counseling/anticipatory guidance/risk factor reduction interventions. These codes could be used to record assessment and counseling for IPV. For instance, this is the description for new patients who are age 18-39:

99385, Initial comprehensive preventive medicine evaluation and management of an individual including an age and gender appropriate history, examination, counseling/anticipatory guidance/risk factor reduction interventions, and the ordering of laboratory/diagnostic procedures, new patient; 18- 39 years.

There are also separate codes (99401-99412) for counseling provided separately, at a different encounter on a different day, from the preventive medicine examination:

- 99401 Preventive medicine counseling and/or risk factor reduction intervention(s) provided to an individual (separate procedure); approximately 15 minutes
- 99402 Preventive medicine counseling and/or risk factor reduction intervention(s) provided to an individual (separate procedure); approximately 30 minutes
- 99403 Preventive medicine counseling and/or risk factor reduction intervention(s) provided to an individual (separate procedure); approximately 45 minutes
- 99404 Preventive medicine counseling and/or risk factor reduction intervention(s) provided to an individual (separate procedure); approximately 60 minutes
- 99411 Preventive medicine counseling and/or risk factor reduction intervention(s) provided to individuals in a group setting (separate procedure); approximately 30 minutes
- 99412 Preventive medicine counseling and/or risk factor reduction intervention(s) provided to individuals in a group setting (separate procedure); approximately 60 minutes

Additionally there are: Expanded set of 23 IPV SNOMED diagnosis and Goal codes that capture education, support and referrals

- Housing
- Legal aid
- Financial supports
- Culturally specific support programs
